	Large expenses for this fiscal year include \$15,750.00 in probono commitments and the expenses associated with attending the annual ACC meeting.
	Ms. Wittmann to check the ACC policy on a chapter's allowable carryover/reserve amount in terms of months of operating expenses.
	Ms. Wittmann and Mr. LaGrone to meet offline regarding expected amount of cash available this fiscal year and options for putting those funds to good use.
Program and Sponsorship Committee	Ms. Vigour and Mr. LaGrone to discuss remaining calendar offline.
	Jackson Lewis discussion: won't chase them this year; calendar is too full and the value proposition is low.
	Discussion re: McGlinchey possibly presenting to ACC Small Law Department; two options: Online CLE (\$5,000 cost), access to over 5000 Small Law members nationwide, or Legal Updates (free), but not CLE. Result: McGlinchey is not an ACC sponsor this year, and unfortunately there is no room this year for another sponsor or event, but there are opportunities available in future years.
	Deutsch Kerrigan status is unclear (checking to determine if they are a rollover from last year).
	We could squeeze in two programs in October (Jones Walker) and two in November (Galloway); Litchfield will be in September. Cannot do two programs in December due to other planned events.
