Internship Description: The Intern will support in-house counsel with research, writing and other legal work in various practice areas such as patents, employment law, litigation, mergers and acquisitions, and transactional legal work. The intern will rotate between three corporate law offices located in Metropolitan Atlanta for three or four week periods during the program.

Number of Available Internships: One

Dates: Full time 10-week program beginning June 7, 2010 through August 13, 2010

Criteria: The program is open to Minority law students who have just completed their first year of law school. Strong academic credentials are required. Interest in corporate in-house practice and community service experience preferred.

Stipend: \$10,000 grant funded by ACC-Georgia
