1. To create a successful legal operations team, **build diverse teams** of lawyers and non-lawyers, and consider bringing on data analysts, risk analysts, and others. According to the 2019 ACC Chief Legal Officers Survey (CLO Survey), most CLOs anticipate increasing staffing levels in 2019. 32% anticipate adding in-house counsel, 15% will add legal operations professionals, and 19% foresee adding paralegals in 2019.

2. Keep this sense of **balance in technology solutions**, too. While the largest departments may need some “bespoke” software, most companies will be better off using “off the shelf” solutions for their software needs.
