- > **Document management** and knowledge sharing
- Capturing data on volumes and work types
- System administration of basic tasks (alerts, reminders, etc.)
- > Legal processes and workflows administered through technology (intake/ request management, matter tracking and closure, e-Billing)
- MI and Reporting generated in real time to demonstrate value, manage resources and justify investment
- Document automation in place to improve efficiency of drafting

- > **Self-service** tools in place to enable business processes
- > Using data to drive continuous improvement and future technology strategy
- Opportunities for further automation, Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Robotic Process Automation (RPA) being assessed and implemented
