

The mission of ACC NCR's Corporate Scholars Program is to give students from law schools in our service area an introduction to in-house practice – a career option about which they might know little – and to develop a diverse pipeline of future in-house counsel. The definition of diversity for the program is very broad, encompassing not only gender, race, and ethnicity, but also socioeconomic background and the student's education and career path. The goal is to provide opportunities for populations within law schools that may lack access to or knowledge about in-house practice. Since its creation in 2004, the Corporate Scholars Program has placed more than 199 students in summer internships with member companies and organizations.

The Corporate Scholars Committee leads and manages the ACC NCR Corporate Scholars Program, which includes interviewing and selecting the members of each year's Class of Scholars, selecting the Scholars' Host placements, developing programs to complement the Scholars' internship experiences, and engaging with the Scholars community (including alums).







Number of Years In-House



HISTORY

- The Washington Metropolitan Area Corporate Counsel Association ("WMACCA") was founded in 1980 to "provide a forum for discussion of the concerns of corporate legal counsel in the Washington, D.C., metropolitan area." We were one of the first organizations of corporate staff attorneys in the United States.
- ACC was founded in 1982 by a group of general counsel who believed that in-house counsel needed their own organization focused exclusively on in-house issues and networks.
- WMACCA affiliated with ACC in late 1983 as the Washington Metro Area chapter.
- In 2006, WMACCA broadened its service area from Washington, D.C. and the surrounding Virginia and Maryland suburbs, to include all ACC members throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- In January 2015, WMACCA became the ACC National Capital Region chapter, in order to better describe the area it serves and more closely identify with ACC and other chapters.






