

CORPORATE SCHOLARS COMMITTEE

The mission of ACC NCR's Corporate Scholars Program is to give students from law schools in our service area an introduction to in-house practice – a career option about which they might know little – and to develop a diverse pipeline of future in-house counsel. The definition of diversity for the program is very broad, encompassing not only gender, race, and ethnicity, but also socioeconomic background and the student's education and career path. The goal is to provide opportunities for populations within law schools that may lack access to or knowledge about inhouse practice. Since its creation in 2004, the Corporate Scholars Program has placed more than 199 students in summer internships with member companies and organizations.

The Corporate Scholars Committee leads and manages the ACC NCR Corporate Scholars Program, which includes interviewing and selecting the members of each year's Class of Scholars, selecting the Scholars' Host placements, developing programs to complement the Scholars' internship experiences, and engaging with the Scholars community (including alums).
