Max has also handled multiple data breach class actions — including for major transportation industry and health care clients — and has deep knowledge of the data breach litigation and settlement landscape. Max has particular experience defending claims brought under federal privacy statutes, such as the Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA), and a host of state consumer protection laws, including California's Unfair Competition Law (UCL) and Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA).
