

"A lawyer employed or retained by an organization represents the organization acting through its duly authorized constituents."

- ABA Model Rules 1.13(a)

#### **Advisor Role**

"In representing a client, a lawyer shall exercise independent professional judgment and render candid advice. In rendering advice, a lawyer may refer not only to law but to other considerations such as moral, economic, social and political factors, that may be relevant to the client's situation."

- ABA Model Rules 2.1



- ABA Model Rules 1.1























#### Confidentiality


"A lawyer shall not reveal information relating to the representation of a client unless the client gives informed consent, the disclosure is impliedly authorized in order to carry out the representation or the disclosure is permitted by paragraph (b)."

- ABA Model Rules 1.6(a)
