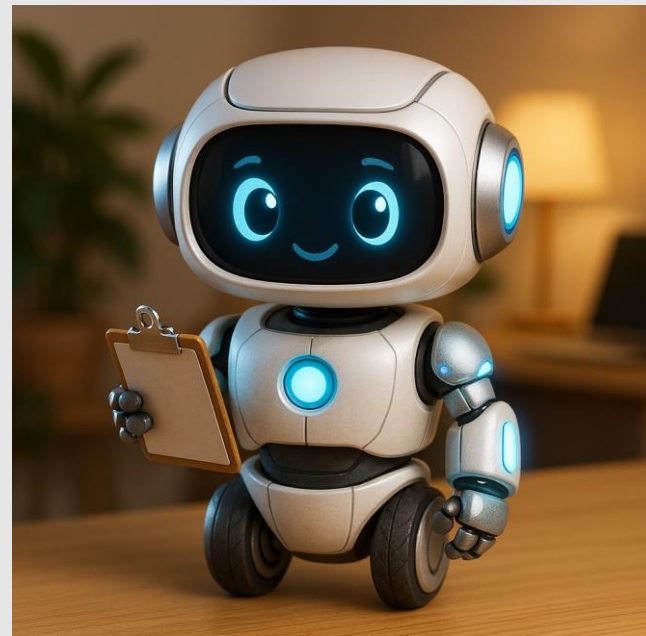


The Basics of Agentic AI

Not your average chatbot!

Key characteristics include

- Autonomy
- Reasoning
- Adaptability
- Contextual understanding
- Action-enabled capabilities



Great for high volume tasks, complex decisions, human interaction, research and analysis.

Generative AI vs. Agentic AI



A **generative AI** tool can create a new internal compliance policy to reflect the regulatory changes identified by the agentic AI tool.

An **agentic AI** tool would continuously monitor the updates from regulatory bodies and check whether internal policies remain aligned with regulatory changes.



Best Practices

- Understand how your company uses AI
- Use the right inputs - no personal data/ trade secrets if not necessary
- Quality assure content to avoid bias and IP issues
- Be transparent in the process and results
- Continue to use human intelligence
- Conduct diligence on AI vendors and review contracts
- Implement clear use policies
- Ethical obligations

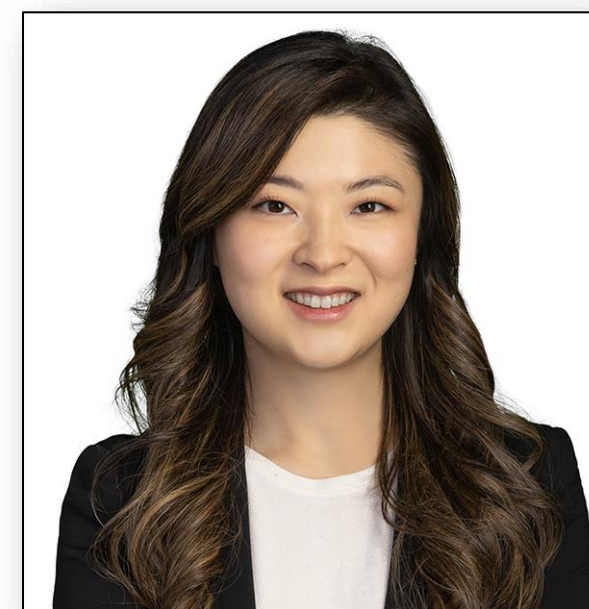
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
