

Drafting – Contract Terms

UCC § 2-301 – General Obligations of Parties

- Quantity
- Price
- Time of Delivery





Drafting – Contract Terms

- Other Delivery Concerns
 - UCC 2-307 Delivery
 - UCC 2-324 No Arrival, No Sale
 - UCC 2-613 Casualty to Identified Goods
- Unspecified Terms
 - UCC 2-311





Drafting – Anticipating Shortages and Allocating Risk

Contract language can be used to spread risk when there are

supply shortages.

- Pro-Buyer
- Pro-Supplier





Drafting – Limitation of Liability & Indemnification

 Clauses may address liability for incidental damages resulting from a disruption in the supply chain, and whether a party can "look up" the supply chain for indemnity.
