Tips on Handshaking: Personal Image		
* For a woman to make her hand seem larger and more substantial when shaking hands with a man she should extend her hand with the index finger slightly separated from her middle finger. The space is not perceived, only the total width.		
* Always rise when introductions are being made and you are shaking hands.		
* Never shake hands across a table or other impediment.		
* Always smile while shaking hands.		
* Try to be the one to extend your hand first. This shows authority and confidence.		
* Use one hand, not two when shaking hands. Two-handed handshakes can either be one	hand over and one hand under (this means
